Sandra Harris and Shari Bickel were previously soloists with the Ballet Theater of Annapolis from 1991 until 1999. Sandra and Shari went on to join the professional contemporary dance company, "TMC" for their 2000 season. They attended Baltimore School for the Arts and Towson State University.

Both Sandra and Shari were trained in the Russian method of classical ballet. The travelled to Russia to train under the direction of Nikita Dolgushin, founder of the Leningrad Conservatory for music and dance with Towson University's student exchange program.

Sandra and Shari have trained, choreographed, and performed a variety of dance disciplines through the state of Maryland. These include Ballet Theater of Annapolis "The School", County Ballet, Ballet Royale Academy, The Talent Machine, Part II Dance Company, Susan Ina's Dance Studio, Experimental Dance Concepts and Harford Dance Theatre. Sandra and Shari have also formed a collaboration with senior members of WMBA and formed the contemporary Christian dance company, "Unspoken Grace".

REHEARSAL ASSISTANTS / GUEST PERFORMERS

Lauren Amrhein began training at Mid-Atlantic Center for Performing Arts before coming to White Marsh Ballet Academy in 2006. While at WMBA, Lauren performed in the dance company in roles such as the Sugar Plum Fairy in the Nutcracker and Beauty in Beauty and the Beast. Lauren attended the University of Maryland and graduated in 2016 with a B.S. in Chemical Engineering and graduated in 2017 with a M.S. in Chemical Engineering. Now, Lauren works as an Evaluator at the Army Evaluation Center when she is not teaching. Lauren continues to perform as a guest artist in WMBA Dance Company performances. Lauren also performs locally with Charm City Ballet. Lauren has been teaching at WMBA since 2011.

Katie Hauf began dance at the age of three at White Marsh Rec. Council. There she performed lead roles in ballets such as Beauty and the Beast, Cinderella, The Nutcracker, The Wizard of Oz, and Giselle. Katie moved to White Marsh Ballet Academy when they opened their doors in the fall of 1997. Her repertoire with BDE includes, Swan Lake, Seasons, and Snow Queen and Dew Drop from The Nutcracker to name a few. Katie began teaching for WMBA in 2000. She has also guest choreographed Cirque for both BDE and WMBA Dance Company. Katie attended Goucher College where she obtained her bachelor's degree in Dance and Elementary Education in 2003. As a Senior Teacher for WMBA, Katie has been promoted to Teacher Coordinator.

Nicole Ford began her training at the age of 5 and has studied at White Marsh Ballet Academy for the majority of her training. She was a member of the White Marsh Ballet Academy Dance Company and has been cast in roles such as Russian lead, Arabian lead, Paquita lead, and the Sugar Plum Fairy. For 3 years, she has performed as a member of Unspoken Grace, a Christian Dance Company. Nicole has performed throughout the local community. She is a graduate from the prestigious, George Washington Carver Center for Arts and Technology, Dance program. Nicole was a trainee with Ballet Theatre of Maryland Dance Company during it's 2021-2022 season.

Kaitlyn Winner began dancing at the age of 4 and has been performing with WMBA since 2003. She is currently a choreographer, instructor, and guest performer with WMBA. Kaitlyn holds a BS Degree in Psychology from Towson University and is MS Degree in Clinical Professional Counseling Psychology from Loyola University Maryland. She a Licensed Graduate Professional Counselor and is currently working at Loyola University Maryland as the Assistant Director of Career Readiness within their Career Center.
